- Your home university is a partner university of the Catholic University of Applied Sciences Freiburg (Katholische Hochschule Freiburg, KH Freiburg).
- Your English language skills are level B2
- German language skills are an asset
- Your field of study at your home university matches the study programs offered at KH Freiburg: Social and Health Care Sciences
- You are highly motivated to study at KH Freiburg

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## Study options in English language in autumn/winter semester 2024/2025

You may choose any class in any field. Slight changes may occur. The assignments will be per class. This structure helps us to give you an overview on what kind of classes are taught in English. The classes are always mixed – KH students and exchange students, with the exception of the German class. (Please note that there can be slight changes in the program)

1. Cross cultural and international competences	ECTS
Here you have choice of classes promoting cross cultural competences. Some classes teach theoretical and practical insights into questions of culture, migration-sensitivity or cross-cultural comparisons, other classes are part of international exchange projects or present international research or practical projects. Furthermore, you can choose language courses, KH recommends to take the German course and the English course.
